Blair's legacy to Scotland

Today Scotland faces a stark choice. Do we play host to a new generation of Britain's nuclear weapons or seek a future free from Weapons of Mass Destruction? The recent White Paper spells it out. Tony Blair's legacy to Scotland will be to saddle us with Britain's nuclear weapons for the next 50 years for the staggering cost of £50-100 billion.

No reduction

And contrary to Government claims, this is no reduction in our nuclear arsenal. The number of warheads deployed will be exactly the same as on the existing system. But a new, more accurate warhead will pose a new threat to nuclear and non-nuclear nations across the world. This will trigger a new round in the nuclear arms race and encourage non-nuclear countries to 'go nuclear'.

No military threat

And all this in a situation where the government admits that Britain faces no significant military threat now or in the foreseeable future. Trident did not deter the attacks of 7/7 in London and won't stop further terrorist attacks.
