Resolution 1: From CND North-East Scotland / Campaigning for Peace

We note the ever-growing potential for Nuclear War in the following Scenarios:

- *The War between Russia and Ukraine/ NATO*
- *The expanding conflict in the Middle East*
- *The growing tensions in the Pacific between China and the US and Allies*
- *The Growing tensions between North Korea and South Korea/ US and allies*

We ask that Scottish CND:

- 1. raise its concerns about the potential for Nuclear War with elected politicians, the media, religious leaders, trade unions etc*
- 2. work with other concerned groups such as Stop the War to promote public awareness of the potential for Nuclear War*
- 3. produce a leaflet laying out our concerns, identifying the driving forces behind the escalating danger of nuclear war, and what measures should be taken to remediate*
